DIRECTIONS

FROM THE NORTH: Rt 33 South to the Bath exit - make a left onto Rt 512 North. Turn right onto Sullivan Trail (Rt 115) at traffic light. Follow Rt 115 to State Park Rd (aprox 1.5 miles.) Make right onto State Park Rd Club grounds will be on your right.

FROM THE SOUTH: Rt 33 North to the Belfast exit, make a right off the exit & then turn left onto Sullivan Trail (Rt 115) Follow Sullivan Trail and make a left onto State Park Rd. Club grounds will be on your right.
