B. MODIFIED HUNTER DERBY -- Entry Fee - \$25

The Hunter Derby is designed to resemble the hunt field with brush jumps and natural fences. Its purpose is to return Hunters to their hunt-field roots. This particular Modified Hunter Derby will consist of ten fences at 2"6" and you may be required to jump out of the ring over a brush-like fence. There will also be option fences that will be set at 3' and the horse/rider combination can earn extra points by taking the higher option.

(A special award will be presented to the overall Hunter Derby high point horse/rider combination from both Blue Valley shows)
